# STUDENT ATHLETE AWARDS 2012

## About the Awards

Now entering their second year, the Schultz Toomey O'Brien Lawyers Student Athlete Awards are aimed at formally recognising and supporting our sporting heroes at a school level. The cost of training, coaching and even transporting children in their sporting endeavours can be an expensive exercise. These awards will not only provide recognition but some financial support to both the school and the individuals who are the monthly winners.

## How it works

The awards will be held over a nine month period from February to October. All primary and secondary schools in the Sunshine Coast area are encouraged to submit their entries for an individual or team who has a sporting achievement they believe is worthy of not just the recognition of winning this prestigious award, but also the financial support it offers. A judging panel will review the entries on the 22nd of each month and, just prior to end of the month, a winner will be selected.

The school will be notified they have the winning student that month and we will then arrange for the Hot 91.1 Breakfast Team to provide a free outside broadcast on a Friday at the end of the month. This outside broadcast will be able to highlight and promote several aspects of the school and offer the children attending a healthy breakfast together with the chance to participate in some activities throughout the morning. During the outside broadcast Hot 91.1 will interview the monthly winner of the Schultz Toomey O'Brien Lawyers Student Athlete Award. The Sunshine Coast Daily and Seven Local News will be there to cover the morning and will photograph/film the event.

During November, all nine monthly winners and their school will be featured in the Sunshine Coast Daily. Readers will be encouraged to vote for the Sunshine Coast Daily "People's Choice Award", with the winner announced at the end of year awards. The People's Choice Award winner will be announced at the End of Year Awards in November.



## PRIZES:

### Monthly Winner:

The school with the winning student will earn the privilege of having Hot 91.1's Breakfast Team host a breakfast at their school on the last Friday of the month. In addition to this the following other prizes will be awarded:

- \$1,000 to the individual winning student (if it is a team the \$1,000 will be shared equally);
- \$1,000 to the school at which the winning student attends to be put towards sporting equipment or similar sporting programs.

### Overall Winner and Sunshine Coast Daily "People's Choice Award"

The overall winning student or team will receive \$5,000 (if it is a team the \$5,000 will be shared equally);

- \$3,000 for the Sunshine Coast Daily People's Choice winner (if it is a team the \$3,000 will be shared equally);
- \$5,000 in advertising for the school, where the winning student attends (or attended at the time of winning the monthly award), to use in the Sunshine Coast Daily over the following 12 months (note this is not redeemable for cash); and
- The Sunshine Coast Daily Readers' Award: Four (4) readers, who submit a vote for one of the monthly winners to receive the "People's Choice" Award will be randomly selected from a barrel at the last presentation. Each of the four people whose names are called will receive \$500 provided by the Sunshine Coast Daily. To be eligible for the Sunshine Coast Daily Readers' Award, a person must have submitted a vote, for one of the monthly winners, using an original entry form found in the paper throughout November. The four winners will be selected randomly.
- Sunshine Coast Daily "People's Choice Award" – all of the monthly winners will be highlighted in the Sunshine Coast Daily throughout November and the public will be encouraged to vote by completing the entry form available in the Sunshine Coast Daily. The person with the most votes will win the "People's Choice Award".

### Eligibility:

These awards are open to all primary and secondary schools, public and private, on the Sunshine Coast. If an entry is unsuccessful in any month, they may be resubmitted for consideration the next month. Entries must be received by the 20th of each month to be included in that month's selection. If they are received after this date they will be held over until the next month's judging.

## Schultz Toomey O'Brien Lawyers –

### Student Athlete Awards

#### Rules and Eligibility Criteria

1. Entries will only be accepted from students currently enrolled in schools located in the Sunshine Coast.
2. The awards are open to all primary and secondary schools, public and private, on the Sunshine Coast.
3. Prizes will be awarded over a period of nine months. February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September and October. The major prize winner and "People's Choice Award" will be awarded in November.
4. Each of the four main questions that require answering on the entry form will be given equal weighting by the judges when determining the monthly winner.
5. To be eligible for the major award or the "People's Choice Award" you must have been a monthly winner on one of the previous nine months and remain enrolled at a school on the Sunshine Coast.
6. "People's Choice Award" – all of the monthly winners will be highlighted in the Sunshine Coast Daily throughout November and the public will be encouraged to vote by completing entry forms available in the Sunshine Coast Daily. The person with the most votes will win the "People's Choice Award".
7. To be considered for a monthly award your entry must be received by the Sunshine Coast Daily no later than the 20th of that month. Any entries received after this date will be held over until the next month.
8. The \$5,000 advertising package that will be won by the school attended by the overall winner cannot be exchanged for cash nor can it be transferred to another party. If a student changes schools after winning a monthly award, it is the school that they are enrolled in at the time of winning the monthly award who will be the winner of this award.
9. The Sunshine Coast Daily Readers' Award is based on luck only. It is open to anyone who submits a vote on the "People's Choice" entry form found in the Sunshine Coast Daily throughout November. All of the readers who have submitted a vote will have their names placed in a barrel and four names will be randomly selected. Each of the four names pulled out will receive \$500 from the Sunshine Coast Daily.
10. All entries must be submitted online through the Sunshine Coast Daily's website link or on the approved nomination form. This form can be obtained from your local school or downloaded from the Sunshine Coast Daily's, Schultz Toomey O'Brien Lawyers or Hot 91.1's website. You can also pick one up from the Reception of the Sunshine Coast Daily, Schultz Toomey O'Brien Lawyers, Hot 91.1 or Seven Sunshine Coast.
11. The nominated judges may be replaced with another judge without the organisers giving notice or a reason as to the change.
12. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The breakfast supplied by Hot 91.1 will cater for a maximum of 300 children.
14. To host an outside broadcast Hot 91.1 will require access to 240v power and a stand-alone phone line.
15. The organisers reserve the right to change the day of the outside broadcast if the last Friday of the month falls during school holidays, or for any other reason.
16. All entries and any information contained therein remain the property of the organisers. Any photos taken of the winners remain the property of the organisers and may be used in future promotion of this event.
17. By entering these awards the nominees and their parents/guardian give their permission to have their photograph appear in the Sunshine Coast Daily or on Seven Local News.
18. Nominees must be an Australian resident.
